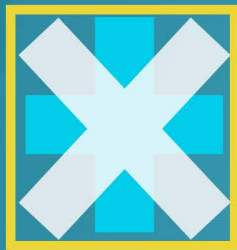

THREE PILLARS OF EVIDENCE

TutorJack's unique learning model is a direct response to education research. Here are the three ideas we feel most strongly about.

1. For actual instruction, 1-on-1 teaching is most effective.

The evidence for this point is extremely strong. Educational psychologist William Bloom found that students who were taught in 1-on-1 settings scored, on average, two standard deviations above the mean. In fact, 90% of the 1-on-1 students performed as well as the top 20% of the group instruction students.

2. Immediate practice and feedback matter.

If 1-on-1 teaching is so effective, why not just do private tutoring? Because immediate, relevant practice matters, and private tutoring isn't the best setting for that. Ideally, students get to practice what they've learned in an independent manner, and it's even better if they're around other students with whom they feel a social connection.

3. Multi-modal learning, including learning-by-teaching, produces better educational outcomes.

Tons of studies from the last couple decades have established that students learn best when they are exposed to new material in a variety of ways. In the 1980s, French educator and researcher Jean-Pol Martin developed a learning-by-teaching model and published significant work showing its benefits. This, along with multi-sensory learning, is proven help students learn faster.

THE TUTORJACK MODEL

Just about every tutoring center follows either a 1-on-1, private tutoring model or a group instruction model. 1-on-1 models are great for instruction but fall short on offering immediate practice and a social context. Group instruction is rarely effective instruction.

TutorJack solves this problem with our unique model.

FIRST,

students learn in custom 1-on-1 glass breakout pods, with the instructor utilizing state-of-the-art interactive teaching displays for a multi-modal education experience.

NEXT,

students practice in the main study area, alongside other students and with the assistance of dedicated instructors who are there to help them if they get stuck.

FINALLY,

students finish their session by teaching the day's concept back to the instructor and completing a special challenge problem, designed to show whether they have truly mastered the concept.

SCHEDULING

TutorJack students choose to come in either two days or three days each week, and scheduling is flexible. You aren't locked into the same day or time each week – our program fits the schedules of busy kids well.
